To provide 198 families in Luwero, Kamuli and Tororo with project management, livestock training and goats

Target: £175,680



Why Plan works in Uganda

In Uganda, one third of the population lives below the poverty line. 80% are farmers; many don't have enough land, tools or knowledge to grow enough to eat or sell. As a result, they can't afford to send their children to school or pay for basic healthcare.

Providing communities with the appropriate skills, knowledge and resources they need to earn a living allows families to support their children's education and ensure their wellbeing.

How you can help

We aim to raise £175,680 to provide 198 families in Luwero, Kamuli and Tororo with the training they need to manage and produce livestock. Female goats will be given to individual families and several male goats will be given to the community to encourage breeding. The skills they learn will provide a strong foundation for sustainability.

This is an ideal way to help people to work their way out of poverty. Goats provide milk and meat which can be used to supplement diet. The sale of offspring will raise much-needed money for schooling and health, and for reinvestment in the family farm.

Plan enables poor communities to take action together to achieve children's rights to an education, decent healthcare, clean drinking water and more. We give long-term practical support so poor communities can improve the lives of their children and themselves. We also campaign to change the way a whole range of adults - from parents to politicians - think and act, because we know their decisions can perpetuate poverty.

Children themselves can be powerful advocates for change, so we encourage them to take part in decision making, from village councils to national assemblies. And because children will be the leaders of tomorrow, we believe that strengthening their voices now will create a fairer, better world - now and in the future.

This is just one of many projects within Plan's wider livelihoods programme. With your support, this project can make a difference to the lives of many children, families and communities in Uganda.
