Objective:
To provide 675 sets of primary school equipment and furniture to schools in all Plan programme areas.

Target: £35,220



Why Plan works in Vietnam

Poverty is widespread in Vietnam with over a third of the population living on less than £1 a day. A quarter of children between five and 14 have no choice but to find work in order to help support their families. In addition to this, low school enrolment and high drop out rates reflect the poor condition and quality of the education system – over 40% of children do not attend secondary school.

Plan recognises that education is a crucial way to beat poverty – enabling boys and especially girls to gain the skills and knowledge they need to pull their communities out of poverty and reach their full potential in life.

How you can help

We aim to raise £23,560 for primary school furniture and equipment. The desks and chairs will stop children from having to sit on hard floors, struggling to learn to read and write. And with valuable items such as blackboards, educational games and books they'll find lessons more stimulating and interesting.

We also aim to raise £11,660 to form community committees. The aim of these groups is to make sure that children's rights become an integral part of everyday life in the community and that children always have the opportunity to have their opinions heard. This will lead to a new generation of adults who can address important issues that affect them and help move their communities forward.

Plan enables poor communities to take action together to achieve children's rights to an education, decent healthcare, clean drinking water and more. We give long-term practical support so poor communities can improve the lives of their children and themselves. We also campaign to change the way a whole range of adults - from parents to politicians - think and act, because we know their decisions can perpetuate poverty.

Children themselves can be powerful advocates for change, so we encourage them to take part in decision making, from village councils to national assemblies. And because children will be the leaders of tomorrow, we believe that strengthening their voices now will create a fairer, better world - now and in the future.

These are just two of many projects within Plan's wider education programme. With your support, these projects can make a difference to the lives of many children, families and communities in Vietnam.
